One member said, *"The use of the Voter Violation Alert sent by Senator Cruz's campaign was disappointing. It reminds me of the kind of campaign tricks that Democrats do to scare black voters to come out and vote. They send out official looking notices that look like they come from the government, saying that voting records are public information and failure to vote could result in a loss of government benefits.
