

1. Reduce the budget (HB 29 and HB30) essential spending across the board and tie all non-essential spending to revenue benchmarks.

2. Amend with a re-enactment clause (requiring re-passage in the 2021 session) ALL measures which add to cost of living or doing business in Virginia, and ALL unfunded mandates to local governments.
