Pregnancy Center OVERVIEW:

Pregnancy centers are life-affirming, non-profit organizations that support, educate, and equip individuals facing unexpected pregnancy.

Virginia pregnancy centers provide free medical, counseling, and support services for women and their partners. These services strengthen families and ensure women have the resources they need for a healthy and hope-filled future.

The 40 pregnancy center locations throughout the Commonwealth are supporting women and families in need every day.



3.5 million in free services provided

Virginia pregnancy centers provided over \$3.5 million in free medical care and support to Virginia families in 2021.



In 2021, Virginia pregnancy centers assisted over 11,000 women and their partners with free services.

2021-2022 SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS:



PREGNANCY TESTING

Virginia pregnancy centers assisted over **9,000 women** with free pregnancy testing services.

ULTRASOUNDS & STI TESTING

Over 6,400 free ultrasounds & 1,300 STI tests were performed by licensed medical professionals to give women important information about their reproductive health.

PREGNANCY & PARENTING EDUCATION

Over **7,100** parenting and life skill classes and one-on-one coaching sessions were provided to women and their partners on topics such as Prenatal Nutrition, Newborn Care, Postpartum Support, and Financial Management.

ESSENTIAL BABY SUPPLIES

Virginia pregnancy centers provided women with over **134,000** free, essential supplies, including prenatal vitamins, formula, boxes of diapers and wipes, baby clothes, baby equipment, and more.

Pregnancy Center SUPPORT & FUNDING:



56,000 hours volunteered

\$14 million generously donated

Over **800** volunteers, including over **60** licensed medical professionals, served at local pregnancy centers. They donated **56,000** volunteer hours to support and empower families.

Over **24,000** individuals and **2,300** churches and organizations donated **\$17 million** to Virginia pregnancy centers in 2021. Virginia pregnancy centers receive **no state funding** and rely on the generosity of their communities to provide compassionate care to families.
